Tips for Putting Your Best Yard Forward

- Keep on mowing high – have your lawnmower set to 2.5 inches until fall arrives
- Don't forget to sweep your sidewalks after mowing
- The weeds are still growing strong – don't let them win the battle!
- Place your garbage and recycling containers out of sight of the street
- Inspect your mailbox carefully and consider replacing it if there are rusted or damaged areas



Lawnmower Maintenance Tips

- ❖ Keep your mower blades sharp – this provides the best cut for your lawn
- ❖ Know your engine – choose the appropriate gasoline, keep the engine clean and clear of debris, and use appropriate engine oil
- ❖ Use fresh gasoline – old gas can affect your lawnmower's performance
- ❖ Remember it has spark plugs and air filters too – check and care for them regularly

Recipe Corner SLOW COOKER SALSA CHICKEN

A fast and easy dinner

Kristi Graham – working mom of 3 – this is a go-to meal for our family on nights I work late, the kids LOVE it and I love how quickly I have it done!

- 4 chicken thighs; boneless, skinless
- 2 chicken breasts; boneless, skinless
- 2 cans whole kernel corn, drained well
- 2 cans black beans, drained well
- 1 jar of favorite salsa
- Shredded cheddar cheese – optional
- Sour cream - optional
- Corn tortilla chips

Arrange chicken pieces in the bottom of the slow cooker. Mix the corn and beans and place on top of the chicken pieces. Pour the salsa over the top of all ingredients. Place the lid on tightly and cook on low for 7-8 hours until the chicken is cooked through.

Serve with cheese, sour cream, and chips if desired.

Leftovers? Shred the chicken and place it with some of the salsa mixture on a tortilla, top with cheese and roll into a burrito. Serve with sour cream and guacamole.
